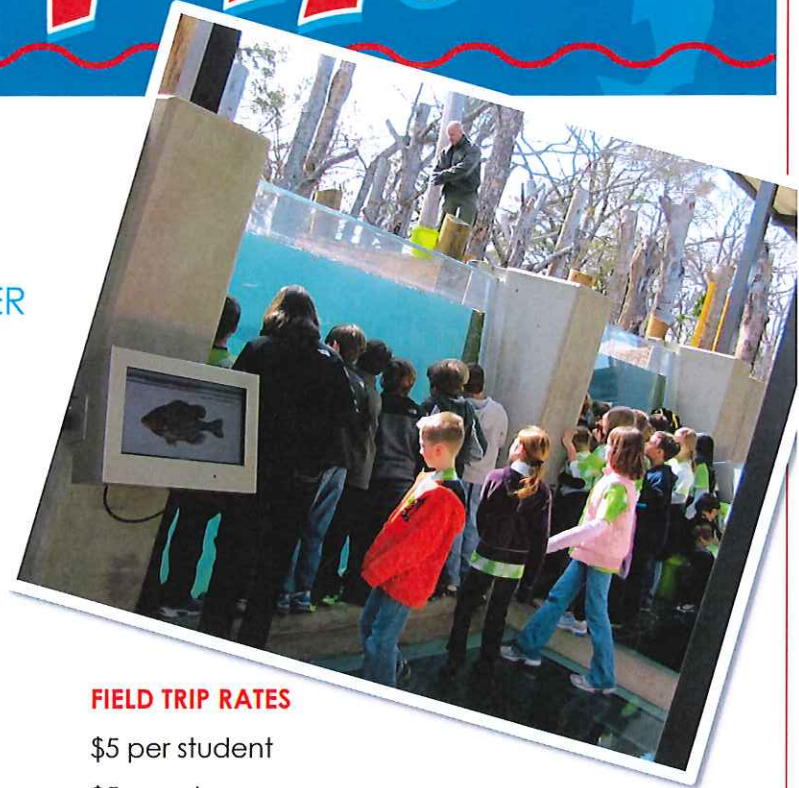


Go Fish!

- See 70 species of live freshwater fish, including Georgia's popular bass and trout, in large outdoor/indoor aquariums.
- Get eye-to-eye with alligators, snakes, turtles and other wildlife.
- Discover Georgia's underwater habitats from mountain streams to blackwater swamps.
- Learn about wildlife that depend on wetlands such as beavers and waterfowl.
- Programs align with the Common Core Georgia Performance Standards.
- Field Trips are scheduled Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- Your visit may include a classroom program with live animals, a guided aquarium tour, and depending on your program, a movie or teacher-led activity.
- The center can accommodate up to three teacher's classes (max 60 students) per day.
- Our Fishing program allows students to cast a line and catch a fish at our onsite fishing pond.
- Schedule allows for a 30 minute school-brought lunch break.
