GUIDED FIELD TRIPS

Get students outdoors to experience an educational journey through Georgia's watersheds. Discover native fish and wildlife and the importance of natural resource conservation in Georgia. Students will get hands-on experience learning how to fish and more!

- Scheduled Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
- The center can currently accommodate up to 60 students per day.
- Guided Field Trips include an introductory fishing program, a guided aquarium tour, and an educational program; aligned to the Georgia Standards of Excellence.
- Explore over 200,000 gallons of aquariums designed to represent Georgia's freshwater habitats; from mountain streams to blackwater swamps.
- Get eye-to-eye with a wide variety of fish, alligators, snakes, turtles, and other wildlife.
- The Introduction to Fishing program allows students an opportunity to learn basic fishing skills, alongside knowledgeable instructors.
- Schedule allows for a 30-minute school-brought lunch break at the end of the field trip.

- \$6 per chaperone
- **Free** for Educators
- \$180 Small Group Flat Rate Fee for groups with 30 students or less. Fee does **not** cover the cost of chaperones.
