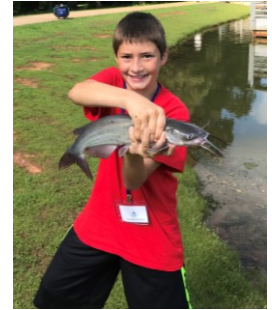

This introductory-level camp is designed for youth, ages 7-15, who would like to get outdoors and learn the basics of fishing. In addition to learning how to fish, campers will also receive instruction on fishing equipment, safety, casting, and cleaning fish. Topics such as fish biology, habitats, and conservation will be explored through guided tours and fun educational activities.

All equipment and bait will be provided. Food and drink will not be provided. Campers will need to bring their own lunch, snacks, and water bottle. Due to limited space, pre-registration is required by June 11th for session 1, June 18th for session 2, July 2nd for session 3, and July 9th for session 4.
