SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Becoming an Outdoors Woman (BOW) scholarship program aims to broaden participation in the 2024 weekend workshop to women 18 and older who could not **attend without financial assistance**. BOW encourages anyone to apply for a scholarship. 6 Scholarships are available (on a limited basis) to those unable to afford the workshop fee. Preference will be given to full-time students, single-parent households, and first-time attendees. You must also submit a BOW Registration form along with your scholarship application.

1. Scholarships are \$200 towards the total cost.
2. Scholarship recipients will be expected to write an article about their BOW experience, which may be published in DNR newsletters and BOW promotional materials.
3. Scholarship applications must be accompanied by the registration form and fee, based on the sleeping location of your choice. This holds your lodging space and your class choices. *If you choose to scan and email your application, someone will call to take payment over the phone when it is received. The scholarship will not be considered complete without this payment.*
