Step 1. CREATE A GO OUTDOORS GEORGIA ACCOUNT ONLINE OR OVER THE PHONE

Create a Go Outdoors Georgia account profile at https://www.gooutdoorsgeorgia.com/ or by calling 1-800-366-2661. If you do not have a Go Outdoors Georgia account, you are required to enter your full Social Security Number below. While online, you can bypass using this application form by purchasing.number.include-number "Purchase Licenses"! If you still need to mail in this application, complete the application, include the documents applicable for the license you need and mail the application, documents, and payment to: LBRU-Lifetime, 2065 US Hwy. 278 SE, Social Circle, GA 30025. Please see the reverse side (or 2nd page) for instructions and detailed documentation requirements. Official USPS postmark date on mailed envelope is used for age eligibility – request local post office to postmark.

Please note that Lifetime Licenses cannot be purchased by calling 1-800-366-2661 or at retail agents that sell recreational hunting and fishing licenses (ex: Walmart, Academy Sports, etc.) due to the document upload requirement. Document upload must be done online by the customer or copies must be provided through the mail as specified above.

Step 3. GEORGIA RESIDENCY DEFINED AND LIFETIME LICENSE INFORMATION

Residency is defined as having in your possession a VALID Georgia Driver's License or VALID Georgia Identification Card issued from the Georgia Department of Driver Services. A person may be a resident of only one state.

Lifetime licenses include the privileges available from these licenses:

- Hunting
- Big Game
- Wildlife Management Area (WMA) Access
- Quota Alligator Harvest Permit if drawn for quota
- Georgia Waterfowl and Migratory Bird
- Freshwater Fishing
- Mountain Trout
- One Durable Lifetime Card (additional cards are available for purchase)

Free Licenses that must be renewed Annually

- State Harvest Record (Deer, Turkey, and Bear harvest record)
- Georgia Waterfowl and Migratory Bird License
- Saltwater Information Permit (SIP) for Saltwater fishing

If you hunt waterfowl and are 16 or older, you will also need to purchase your Federal Duck Stamp. Trapping or other commercial licenses are not included.

If for infant or youth, I will make them aware that any person less than 16 years of age must hunt under adult supervision, except for those 12 to 15 years of age who obtain hunter education to hunt without adult supervision.

LIFETIME SPORTSMAN'S LICENSE

GA Code Reference:

This application has been developed in accordance with Ga. Code 27-2-3.1, which establishes the regulations governing the acquisition and possession of Lifetime Sportsman's Licenses.

Definitions:

- 1. **Resident**: For purposes of this license, "resident" is defined as having in your possession a VALID Georgia Driver's License or VALID Georgia Identification Card issued from the Georgia Department of Driver Services and excludes cards issued as evidence of foreign legal presence in the United States which cannot be accepted (OCGA §40-5-21.1). A person may be a resident of only one state.
- 2. **Birth Certificate**: For infant, youth, and non-resident grandchild licenses, the required birth certificate is a photocopy of either an original or certified copy of a U.S. Birth Certificate / Amended Birth Certificate filed with the State Office of Vital Statistics or equivalent agency in the Applicant's state of birth including U.S. Territories and the District of Columbia; hospital issued birth certificates or hospital notices or announcements of birth are not accepted.

Supporting Document Requirements:

Applications must be accompanied by the following (NO EXCEPTIONS). Send <u>Copies Only</u>—documents will not be returned. USPS postmark date on mailed envelope is used for age eligibility. Request local post office postmark; otherwise, USPS distribution center postmark may be the only postmark applied many days after mailing.

Infant: (Resident or Nonresident, 0-1 Year of Age)

1. Copy of Child's Birth Certificate (see above for description of required birth certificate).

Resident Youth: (2 thru 15 Years of Age)

- 1. Copy of Child's Birth Certificate (see above for description of required birth certificate) AND
- Copy of Parent's Valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card issued by the Department of Driver Services for parent on the Birth Certificate OR

Court order showing parental rights if parent is not listed on the birth certificate and their valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card

Resident Adult: (16-59 Years of Age) (For ages 16&17, requires #1 & #2 from Resident Youth if applicant does not have a VALID Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card)

1. Copy of valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card issued by Department of Driver Services

Resident Senior 65+ / Senior Discount 60+:

- 1. Copy of valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card issued by Department of Driver Services **Resident Veterans:** (Honorably Discharged) Note: Resident Veterans aged 50 & and up should consider other Adult Licenses (ex. 50 thru 59 Years of Age) for a greater reduced price.
 - Copy of valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card issued by Department of Driver Services <u>AND</u>
 - 2. Copy of DD 214: providing satisfactory evidence that applicant served more than 90-days of active federal duty military service and was honorably discharged.

Resident Military: (Active) Note: Resident, Active Military aged 50 & and up should consider other Adult License (Licenses (ex. 50 thru 59 Years of Age) for a greater reduced price.

- 1. Copy of valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card issued by Department of Driver Services AND
- 2. Copy of Valid U.S. Department of Defense Common Access Card with a Uniformed Services Affiliation. Cards can be photocopied to receive State benefits. (32 CFR §161.6(b)(1))

Copy of a Leave and Earning Statement (LES) dated within the last 60-days from the Defense Finance Accounting Service (DFAS)

Non-Resident Grandchild (2 thru 15 Years of Age):

- Copy of Child's Birth Certificate (see above for description of required birth certificate)
 AND
- Copy of Grandparents valid Georgia Driver's License or Georgia Identification Card issued by Department of Driver Services AND
- 3. Provide required information for grandparent's paid lifetime license on page 1 of this application. The free Senior Lifetime License is not eligible.
